

J-1 Irish Work & Travel Program

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

College and University students, or recent graduates, who are citizens of Ireland.

WHAT DOES IT ENTAIL?

The Intern Work & Travel (IWT) Program allows participants to come to the United States, for up to 12 months, to work at a job of their choice and travel.

WHEN CAN I APPLY?

Students can apply at any time! Graduates must begin their internships within 12 months of obtaining their degree.

WHERE CAN I GO?

This program allows you to work and travel anywhere within the United States.

HOW DO I APPLY?

Submit an application with your deposit of US\$ 100. You can find the application form at:
